31st July to 4th of August

DAY 01 As usual, we started a new week with an interesting check-in question to energize the group and create a positive atmosphere. Ready for the new start and excited to continue project work! In the morning we visited **Kvinnocenter in Bergsjön**, an organization working with women in order to empower, give knowledge and help women to find a place in the society. They organise plenty of events, activities and courses. After lunch we had the second edition workshop at the **Entrepreneurship summercamp in Angered**.

DAY 02 We went to **Frölunda Fire Station** where we had a half a day fire protection workshop. First we had a theory class and then we learned how to use fire extinguisher and fire blankets. The workshop was specially designed to help the Safety & Security group with their project. Around the same time frame, the "Job Creation" group had a meeting with Christer Owe and Ola Ekman to discuss the project's progress and brainstorm some more about its connection with **Circle Island**.

DAY 03 The day was almost fully dedicated to the group work on four main projects. After lunch we had a presentation given by **Aleksandra Borzecka** and **Natalie Novik** who told us about their project - "**Others' Space**", a set of strategies for feminist design of public spaces. They developed a "Toolbox" of ideas to tackle the aspect of inclusion in urban life. We had a small workshop and tried to implement the tools into each of our projects.

DAY 04 In the morning we had a study visit to **Svenska Kyrkan in Bergsjön**, an important meeting place in the neighbourhood. We shared ideas and talked about our projects. After lunch we had a **Design Jam**, a learning session when we give feedback and brainstorm on other groups projects as a way to exchange ideas and get out "our own shell". In the end of the day we did a little bit more of group work, to summarise the feedback we got from the other team members.

DAY 05 The first activity we had was a workshop about the user perspective which refers to the perception of actors in the demand side are affected by and/or affected in a specific service or system. As always, we had the weekly progress presentations following in the early part of the afternoon right before ending the week with a check-out question.
